#### RESEARCH GRANTS

#### **CALLING OF APPLICATIONS FOR YEAR 2021**

The National Council for Road Safety (NCRS) is established as a statutory body under the Ministry of Transport by the Act No 5 of Motor Traffic of the Parliament of Sri Lanka.

If has decided to commence research grant scheme to fund research aimed at addressing various road safety issues in Sri Lanka. Research applications will be evaluated mainly on scientific merit but should also propose recommendations that can be implemented. The role of NCRS is to evaluate the feasibility of the work leading, originality of the proposed research outcomes, and how they can contribute towards developing strategies for road safety improvement.

For the research grant scheme for the year 2021, proposals are invited from groups of researchers of public scientific R&D organizations/ universities for funding of target/problem-oriented research projects aimed at reducing the motor cycle related road crashes in Sri Lanka.

Specific objectives of the research grant are to initiate, facilitate and support applied scientific research in the following areas,

- 1. Identify key attributes related to roadway, rider and vehicle that are causal factors for road crashes involved in motor-cycles and propose suitable intervention to address the issues.
- 2. Improve training and evaluation processes involved in the issuance of the driving license for motor cycle riders.

# 1. Eligible Candidates

All Sri Lankan citizens who have completed at least an MPhil degree (full time / part time) from a recognized university or public R&D institution are eligible to apply. Public scientific R & D organization refers to organizations that receive funds for research, or at least provision for it, from the Treasury through the line Ministries, voted in the annual budget by Parliament. [A list of institutions is provided in the application]. Grant applicants, hereinafter called Principal Investigator (P.I.) on prescribed forms available at the Council. Grants are awarded for a period up to a maximum of eight months and the P. I. is the person who undertakes the execution of the research project throughout its approved duration.

# 2. Funding Categories

- 1. Funding will be considered for:
  - **Minor equipment**: Items with single unit values less than Rs. 250,000/-
  - Consumables & Breakables
  - Travel within Sri Lanka
  - Monthly **Stipends and Allowances** for Project Research Assistantship.
- 2. Stipends and allowances will be paid only for those who are not earning salary/do not have an institutional affiliation.
- 3. Funds will not be available for salaries/emoluments of principle investigator (s).
- 4. Repairs to equipment can be considered.
- 5. Costs of upkeep and maintenance should be envisaged at the time of requesting the grant.

# 3. Equipment

The research grant will provide sufficient funds to purchase minor equipment so that it will contribute significantly to institutional infrastructure development, while utilizing to the maximum equipment already available in the collaborating departments / institutions. Inventoried equipment will remain the property of the Council. Upon termination of a project the Council retains the right to transfer it to another project financed by the Council if no prospective immediate use is apparent (as judged by the Council) in the institution where it served the project.

# 4. Project Research Assistantship

Under normal circumstances, the P. I. may request one Project Research Assistant (PRA) per grant. In projects involving a substantial amount of manual field and/or laboratory work, one additional PRA may be requested with strong justification. When a PRA is involved in the grant, the Principal Investigator is solely responsible for the PRA's activities. PRA will be paid only up to 8 months of stipend. The Principal Investigator will undertake to execute the project funded by the Council for the duration of the grant in the institution to which the Principal Investigator belongs and where the work will be mainly carried out. The responsibility of successfully implementing the grant will lie solely with the Principal Investigator, for which the latter is answerable to the Council.

## 5. Declaration from the Institution

Consequently, the grant application should be accompanied by a signed declaration of the Head of the Institution assuring sustained infrastructural support of the Institution to the Principal Investigator and the research project for the duration of the grant. Authorized signatories for each institution (as Head of the Institution) is listed in the 'List of eligible institutions' below.

## 6. Publications

The name of the institution of the Principal Investigator will figure in all publications as the address of where the work was primarily carried out. NCRS should be acknowledged in all publications. Any Intellectual Property Rights ascending from NCRS funded grants should be shared with NCRS. Reprints of publications issuing from the work should be filed with the Council.

#### 8. Format

The applications should be printed in both sides with Font 'Times New Roman' and Font size 12. Late, incomplete and ineligible applications will not be reviewed. Three sets of the duly completed application and its soft copy should reach the National Council for Road Safety office at No -01, D.R.Wijewardene Mawatha, Colombo -10. # 10. Guidelines to fill the Application

## **SECTION - A**

- **A.5.**: Ethical clearance should be obtained prior to the awarding of the grant. Tick where applicable.
- A.6, 7 & 8.: Tick where applicable.
- <u>A.9.</u>: The details requested in A.9. should be of the Principal Investigator. In Postdoctoral fellowship projects the P.I should be the postdoc.
- A.9.4.: The principal Investigator should hold a permanent post.

  All applicants should also state here the percentage of their working time that they intend devoting to the project.
- A.9.7.: Address of the Institute/Department/Laboratory where the work will be carried out, as it will figure in publications and in all correspondence. Telephone, Fax & e-mail.
- **A.9.9 &12.**: The Council currently defines an indexed journal or conference if its indexed in either SCI Expanded publication of SCOPUs publication
- **A.9.12**: If the Principal Investigator is overseas for a long period of time (3 months or more) the grant will not be awarded; however, the Council will make the final decision.
- <u>A.13.</u>: Provide a concise statement of the significance of the proposed work, the hypothesis and major objectives of the project, the procedures to be followed to accomplish the objectives, and the potential impact of the work.

#### **SECTION - B**

**B.2.**: The Council normally expects the findings obtained in the course of research to be published in refereed international journals of repute (e.g. covered by the Science Citation Expanded Index) or a Conference (Scopus Indexed) Exceptions to this may be envisaged if patentable results are produced. The Principal Investigator should point out such likelihood at this juncture.

The Council will consider whether patents will be taken out and held by the Council, however the NCRS will claim 25% the royalty fee of 3% arising from the total sales proceeds from the commercialization of Intellectual Property Right created using the methods developed by the Principal Investigator on a quarterly basis for a period of 5 years and the balance will be credited to the Principal Investigator and his/her Institution.

If the Principal Investigator does not intent to obtain any Intellectual Property Right, the NRC will be entitled to a 1% of the total sales proceeds of the final product, process or service for a period of five years from the date of commercialization.

If outside researchers are expected to have a claim to intellectual property rights afferent to the present project, notably due to a relation discernible in B.1(in the application), that should also be placed before the Council at this juncture or other benefits arising out of the patent. This condition will apply irrespective of the research being supported by other agency, local or foreign.

- C.10.: Give a chronology of all projected operations with time estimation in months. Please note that there will be proposal presentation prior to commencement of the project and a progress review after 3months and 6 months respectively. Draft Final report and presentation to be held at the end of the project duration. Final report to submitted within 1 month of the final presentation.

According to your action plan please fill the work plan (Annex I) in the application, using the format given.
